

# **SUN CITY RYDER CUP GOLF TOURNAMENT**

*MARCH 24-25 2012*

*A Twoball Match (Standard Best Ball)* is when all four golfers play their own ball throughout the round and each hole is won by the team whose individual golfer has the lowest score minus handicap. The team that wins the match receives one point and if the teams tie, they each get 1/2 point for their respective teams.

*A Modified Twosome Match* is when the golfers on the same team take **Alternate Shots** after teeing off. Player "A" & "B" tee off and the best location is selected. After selecting the best location (eg. Player "A's" shot) Player "B," will hit the next shot and the teammates continue to alternate shots with the one ball until the hole is completed. Should both players go OB or lose a ball, one partner will hit the next/provisional shot. Each hole is won by the team that completes the hole in the fewest shots with handicap. The team that wins the match receives one point and if the teams tie they each get 1/2 point for their respective teams.

**Scotch-Scramble** is when both golfers on a team tee off and switch balls for their second shots. Player "A" hits Player "B's" ball and vice versa. Should either player go OB or lose a ball on their first shot, his partner will hit the next/provisional shot. Following this second shot, the team then picks what they feel is the best location and play a Scramble format to the hole. The team that wins the match receives one point and if the teams tie they each get 1/2 point for their respective teams.

A **Second Chance Singles** match is a match play competition between two golfers with handicap. In this match, each player can announce and repeat any one (1) shot per hole, **but they must keep** this shot and continue. The player that wins the match receives one point and if the players tie they each get 1/2 point for their respective team.
